Triumph's Streamliner set the present world's official\* speed record for motorcycles—still standing—at Bonneville Salt Flats, Utah, on August 24, 1962. Rider Bill Johnson (shown above on a 1965 Triumph Bonneville) clocked 230.269 mph.
