Separate point adjustments for precision ignition timing. A rugged single, down-tube frame design that has made the Daytona one of the sweetest handling bikes on the circuit. Illuminated tachometer and speedometer and an anti-theft frame lock.

The Trophy 500 has all of the Daytona's pacesetting qualities in a trail bike configuration and the kind of performance that has made it Grand National Enduro Champion seven times running. A single 26mm Amal concentric carburetor for simple, foolproof adjustment and long-term reliability. Specially designed front forks and adjustable Girling rear suspension with heavily chromed outer springs. A choice of either rugged, super-traction Dunlop Trials Universal trail tires or

K70 Gold Seal road tires. In addition, it offers a variable steering damper for just the right road feel. Adjustable clutch and brake levers to personalize the ride and a protective, heavy duty skid plate.
